



WGA Decision Team Timeline

The Decision Team calendar varies from year to year, but generally follows a similar timeline.

October	WGA requests Letters of Interest (LOIs) from nonprofit agencies seeking funding for programs within WGA's grants focus area
November	Mandatory training for all Decision Team Volunteers
December	Core Team and Volunteer Readers review all LOIs and complete online evaluation forms
December	Core Team meets to determine short list of agencies asked to submit full proposals (RFPs)
January	RFP process information session for agencies
Feb / March	Core Team and Volunteer Readers review and evaluate all proposals using online forms Financial Committee reviews all agency financials to uncover any "red flags" that might put grant dollars at risk
March	Core Team discusses each proposal, creates a list of questions and concerns and narrows to a shorter list of agencies
April	Core Team makes site visits, focuses on questions and concerns
April	Entire Decision Team reviews site visit reports, completes online evaluations and ranks proposals independently
May	Core Team meets to collectively discuss and rank fundable proposals, evaluate grants and collectively make funding recommendations from the Grant Pool
May	Final approval sought from Grants Leadership Team and Steering Committee
May	Membership ratifies final recommendations
June	TCF approval, contracts created/signed and first funds disbursed
