



2020 - 2022 WGA REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

GENERAL INFORMATION

As a result of the Letter of Interest your nonprofit organization submitted, The Women's Giving Alliance (WGA) invites your organization to submit a full **Proposal** for its 2020 - 2022 grant cycle.

The focus of WGA continues to be: Breaking the Cycle of Female Poverty – Intervention and Prevention.

WGA seeks proposals for programs that provide women and/or girls in Northeast Florida with effective and sustainable tools to break the cycle of female poverty. To be eligible, all proposals must serve clients in one or more of the five counties comprising Northeast Florida (Duval, Nassau, St. Johns, Baker and/or Clay).

WGA is particularly interested in proposals that target *Intervention and/or Prevention*, and:

- Offer approaches to counter obstacles to breaking the cycle of female poverty including but not limited to: transportation, enrollment fees, legal barriers, housing, transportation, education
- Are easily accessible to women and/or girls (e.g. provided directly in their neighborhoods, communities, schools or workplaces)
- Are evidence-based and achieve measurable results
- Offer a sustainable, lasting impact (e.g. two-generational)
- Offer strong support services (e.g. peer support, mentoring, trauma-informed intervention, intensive case management)
- If targeting prevention, focus on:
 - Preparing girls and women for high demand, high-paying jobs, or
 - Education and mentoring, from earliest childhood, to improve the likelihood of economic stability for girls and women
 - Reproductive Health
- Offer a strategic, comprehensive and integrated approach (e.g. wrap-around services) or partner with others to achieve this approach

The grants are for two years and are paid in installments. WGA members will make two scheduled visits during the grant cycle to monitor progress. **Important: The WGA funding focus for 2020-2022 is breaking the cycle of female poverty. If WGA changes its focus in the future, renewals for the current focus will not be an option when the two-year grant expires in 2022. Agencies should plan to secure sustaining funds.**
